

Things to Know About Taking The TEAS FOR ALLIED HEALTH

- 1) The TEAS FOR ALLIED HEALTH exam is given on scheduled days at the SPC Testing Center on the Levelland Campus and Reese Center.
 - a) Please check with the <u>SPC Testing Center web page</u> for schedule of testing dates, registration details, and study tools.
- 2) You must register 3 (three) days in advance of the scheduled test date.
- 3) You will need one of the following valid forms of current government identification:
 - a) driver license
 - b) passport
- 4) DO NOT BE LATE for your scheduled exam. You will not be allowed to take the test if you are late.
- 5) Keep your username and password you'll need these if you retest.
- 6) The TEAS FOR ALLIED HEALTH tests Reading, English, Math, and Science.
 - a) Each section is timed.
 - b) All 4 sections will be used for scoring.
- 7) Contact a PTA Program faculty advisor for any questions about how the TEAS is used in your PTA Program Application Process.
 - a) You must make 70% as your overall score to be considered "Passing".
 - i) If you take the TEAS for Allied Health more than once, high scores from each exam section can be used to achieve the 70% overall score.
 - b) You may bring your test results to a PTA Program faculty advisor after you complete your exam if you have any questions.
